



#### **PTAB Inventory – Pending Ex Parte Appeals** (excluding appeals from reexamination proceedings)







#### **Receipts & Dispositions Summary Report** FY 2015 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter


#### Receipts & Dispositions Summary Report FY-2015 3rd Quarter





- Nationwide listening tour conducted in April and May 2014
- Federal Register Request for Comments published in June 2014

- A wide range of feedback was received
  - Non-rule specific comments
  - Comments directed to the seventeen questions posed for public input

## **AIA Trial Rulemaking**

- In response to stakeholder requests, the Office will move forward with two rule packages:
  - 1. A first package, which will go into effect upon publication, encompasses less difficult "quick-fixes" based upon both stakeholder comments and internal PTAB suggestions. Changes in response to stakeholder comments go into effect immediately, via scheduling orders. Plan to issue in Q3 of FY 2015.
  - 2. A second package, issued as proposed rules, will address more difficult changes to the rules, and also will include any changes to the Trial Practice Guide. Plan to issue in Q3 or Q4 of FY 2015.
- The first and second packages will issue together as a single final rule package.

## **AIA Trial Rulemaking**

### **Quick-Fixes for Immediate Implementation**

- Increased the number of pages for a motion to amend from 15 to 25 pages, with a commensurate increase in the number of pages for the opposition, in addition to allowing the Patent Owner to list the amended claims in an appendix.
- Increased the number of pages for a Petitioner's reply brief from 15 to 25 pages.




### **USPTO Locations**





#### Judge Members of the Board As of April 20, 2015




### **PTAB Office Location Demographics**

PTAB Paneling Judges – General Principles

- Consider Judge Characteristics
  - Recusal List
  - Technology expertise
  - Tenure at PTAB and amount of experience in the various jurisdictions of PTAB
  - Current workload
- Consider Panel Make-up
  - Related cases are assigned to the same panel
  - A panel should consist of a mix of experience levels
  - For a heard case, at least one judge should be able to appear in person in the hearing room

Goals of patent attorney program:

- Assist judges with cases to increase overall Board output capacity
- Serve as a pipeline for future judges

Hired 4 Supervisory Patent Attorneys Hired 19+ Patent Attorneys, most of whom will on-board in Q3

During FY 2015, PTAB is planning to hire 20 additional patent attorneys to start in Q1 of FY 2016
